

STAFFORD, Frederick

- 1853.03.00 Mr Stafford a passenger on the *Lady of the Lake* from London, Intermediate. (Durban Local History Museum. Shipping Lists)
- 1853.06.07 ANC between Edward Sparrow Stafford and Mary Anna Walcott signed. Witnesses: Edwin Challinor and Frederick Stafford. (RSC IV/12/13 No. 56)
- 1856.10.00 Frederick Stafford signed a petition of Durban residents. (CSO 2245 No. D480)
- 1878.04.14 He [Edward Sparrow Stafford] had two brothers who followed him to Natal, one on the *Lady of the Lake*. (Capt. Taylor) – he died in the Orange Free State – the other [George] was second mate of a ship bringing timber to Natal in 1862, he died in the magazine explosion in Kokstad. (Kit Bird Papers)
